

## Wisdom

**Heb 2:1** We must, therefore, pay even more attention to what we have heard, so that we will not drift away

**Isaiah 11:2** The Spirit of the Lord will rest on Him—a Spirit of wisdom and understanding, a Spirit of counsel and strength, a Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the Lord.

**Matthew 12:42** The queen of the south .. came from the ends of the earth to hear the wisdom of Solomon; and look—something greater than Solomon is here!

**James 3:17** But the wisdom from above is first pure, then peace-loving, gentle, compliant, full of mercy and good fruits, without favoritism and hypocrisy.

**Proverbs 8:11** For wisdom is better than jewels, and nothing desirable can compare with it.

**Proverbs 16:16** Get wisdom— how much better it is than gold! And get understanding— it is preferable to silver.

**Proverbs 24:14** If you find wisdom, you will have a future, and your hope will never fade.

**Ecclesiastes 2:13** And I realized that there is an advantage to wisdom over folly, like the advantage of light over darkness.

**Ecclesiastes 7:11** Wisdom is as good as an inheritance and an advantage to those who see the sun

**Ecclesiastes 7:12** because wisdom is protection as money is protection, and the advantage of knowledge is that wisdom preserves the life of its owner.

**Ecclesiastes 7:19** Wisdom makes the wise man stronger than ten rulers of a city.

**Ecclesiastes 8:1** A man's wisdom brightens his face, and the sternness of his face is changed.

**Ecclesiastes 9:18** Wisdom is better than weapons of war, but one sinner can destroy much good.

**Exodus 28:3** You are to instruct all the skilled craftsmen, whom I have filled with a spirit of wisdom, to make Aaron's garments for consecrating him to serve Me as priest.

**Proverbs 3:19** The Lord founded the earth by wisdom and established the heavens by understanding.

**Deuteronomy 34:9** Joshua son of Nun was filled with the spirit of wisdom because Moses had laid his hands on him.

**1 Kings 4:30** Solomon's wisdom was greater than the wisdom of all the people of the East, greater than all the wisdom of Egypt.

**1 Kings 3:28** All Israel heard about the judgement the king had given, and they stood in awe of the king because they saw that God's wisdom was in him to carry out justice.

**1 Kings 10:24** The whole world wanted an audience with Solomon to hear the wisdom that God had put in his heart.

**2 Chronicles 1:10** Now grant me wisdom and knowledge so that I may lead these people, for who can judge this great people of Yours?"

**James 1:5** Now if any of you lacks wisdom, he should ask God, who gives to all generously and without criticizing, and it will be given to him.

**Job 12:12** Wisdom is found with the elderly, and understanding comes with long life.

**Job 13:5** If only you would be altogether silent! For you, that would be wisdom.

**Job 28:23** But God understands the way to wisdom, and He knows its location.

**Psalms 37:30** The mouth of the righteous utters wisdom; his tongue speaks what is just.

**Ecclesiastes 2:26** For to the man who is pleasing in His sight, He gives wisdom, knowledge, and joy,

**Psalms 51:6** Surely You desire integrity in the inner self, and You teach me wisdom deep within.

**Psalm 90:12** Teach us to number our days carefully so that we may develop wisdom in our hearts.

**Psalm 111:10** The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom; all who follow His instructions have good insight.

**Proverbs 1:20** Wisdom calls out in the street; she raises her voice in the public squares.

**Proverbs 2:1** My son, if you accept my words and store up my commands within you, listening closely to wisdom and directing your heart to understanding; ... then you will understand the fear of the LORD and discover the knowledge of God.

**Proverbs 3:13** Happy is a man who finds wisdom and who acquires understanding,

**Proverbs 4:4** Your heart must hold on to my words. Keep my commands and live. Get wisdom, get understanding; don't forget or turn away from the words of my mouth. Don't abandon wisdom, and she will watch over you; love her, and she will guard you.

**Proverbs 4:7** Wisdom is supreme—so get wisdom. And whatever else you get, get understanding.

**Proverbs 7:4** Say to wisdom, "You are my sister," and call understanding your relative.

**Proverbs 8:12** I, Wisdom, share a home with shrewdness and have knowledge and discretion. **Shrewd:** having or showing sharp powers of judgement; astute:

**Proverbs 9:1** Wisdom has built her house; she has carved out her seven pillars.

**Proverbs 10:13** Wisdom is found on the lips of the discerning

**Proverbs 10:23** As shameful conduct is pleasure for a fool, so wisdom is for a man of understanding.

**Proverbs 10:31** The mouth of the righteous produces wisdom

**Proverbs 11:2** When pride comes, disgrace follows, but with humility comes wisdom.

**Proverbs 13:10** Arrogance leads to nothing but strife, but wisdom is gained by those who take advice.

**Proverbs 14:8** The sensible man's wisdom is to consider his way, but the stupidity of fools deceives them.

**Proverbs 18:4** The words of a man's mouth are deep waters, a flowing river, a fountain of wisdom.

**Proverbs 21:30** No wisdom, no understanding, and no counsel will prevail against the Lord.

**Proverbs 23:23** Buy—and do not sell—truth, wisdom, instruction, and understanding.

**Proverbs 24:7** Wisdom is inaccessible to a fool; he does not open his mouth at the gate.

**Proverbs 28:26** The one who trusts in himself is a fool, but one who walks in wisdom will be safe.

**Proverbs 29:15** A rod of correction imparts wisdom, but a youth left to himself is a disgrace to his mother.

**Proverbs 31:26** She opens her mouth with wisdom and loving instruction is on her tongue.

**Ecclesiastes 1:17** I applied my mind to know wisdom and knowledge, madness and folly; I learned that this too is a pursuit of the wind.

**Ecclesiastes 10:1** Dead flies make a perfumer's oil ferment and stink; so a little folly outweighs wisdom and honour.

**Jeremiah 9:23** This is what the Lord says: The wise man must not boast in his wisdom; the strong man must not boast in his strength; the wealthy man must not boast in his wealth.

**Ezekiel 28:4** By your wisdom and understanding you have acquired wealth for yourself. You have acquired gold and silver for your treasuries. By your great skill in trading you have increased your wealth, but your heart has become proud because of your wealth.

**Daniel 1:17** God gave these four young men knowledge and understanding in every kind of literature and wisdom.

**1 Corinthians 1:20** Where is the philosopher? Where is the scholar? Where is the debater of this age? Hasn't God made the world's wisdom foolish?

**1 Corinthians 1:25** God's foolishness is wiser than human wisdom, and God's weakness is stronger than human strength.

**1 Corinthians 2:7** On the contrary, we speak God's hidden wisdom in a mystery, a wisdom God predestined before the ages for our glory.

**1 Corinthians 3:18** No one should deceive himself. If anyone among you thinks he is wise in this age, he must become foolish so that he can become wise.
